



The Canadian Falcon Fairlane Comet Club was first organized by a very small group of Ford Falcon owners in 1982 and as the core group actively sought more members, the club was founded in 1983.

The intent of the founding members was to form a club dedicated to the preservation of the 1960-1970 Ford Falcon by organizing owners of these vehicles for mutual support.

In 1990, the membership voted to invite the owners of Ford Fairlane and Mercury Comet vehicles built between 1960 and 1970 to join our ranks and the club name was revised the Lower Mainland Falcon Fairlane Comet Owners Association. Interest from many areas outside the Lower Mainland had us nationalize our non-profit society, which later became the Canadian Falcon Fairlane Comet Club.

Our aim is still the preservation of the "light" Fords, 1960-1970 Falcons, Fairlanes, and Comets.

As a club we try to attend as many auto related and social functions as possible throughout the season, preference given to events sponsored by other "Ford" clubs.
